PAVE is a unique school-based violence prevention program combining classroom education with individual and group counseling. PAVE works with students (K-12) living with family or dating violence, harassment, bullying, and anger—serving both the victim and the perpetrator. PAVE staff members develop and utilize curricula addressing gender issues, healthy relationships (KNOW ABUSE™), and young men and women's anger issues.
