### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

#### **REGISTRATION TABLE (6-8:30am):**

Help to check in participants that have pre-registered. This position will include ensuring that all participants sign a waiver, have their hand stamped, receive a t-shirt, and receive a tear-off ticket.

#### **SHOE TABLE (6-8:30am):**

Many of our participants will carry their shoes with them, but many will have the option of using backpacks to carry their shoes with them. However, we will be responsible for any shoes left at the start line.

#### **REFRESHMENT TABLE (6-10am):**

Help to make sure that everyone stays hydrated and energized by handing out granola bars and water.

#### **GREETERS/ "SUPPORTERS" (6-9am):**

Since there are so many entrances to the mall, we would like to have a pair of greeters available at the 4 main doors to direct participants to Macy's Court. Once the walk is about to start, we would like greeters to move to the walk route and hold signs to encourage all our walkers.

#### **FLOOR VOLUNTEERS/BANNER VOLUNTEERS (6-9am):**

We need volunteers in the event space to help direct participants where to go to register, get their shoes, line up for the walk, and answer general questions. Once registration is complete, we would like floor volunteers to help hold the banner at the start/finish line.

#### **TAKE DOWN (to be completed by 10am):**

We are hoping that volunteers from each area can stay past their shift to be available to help with clean up. Your assistance with take down would be greatly appreciated. We will need to be quick and efficient to clean up before the mall opens.
